# **Training (Monday and Tuesday)**

The two days of training will offer users the opportunity to learn from several of ns-3's software maintainers about the scope and capabilities of the tools, how to run simulations, and how to write new code for ns-3.

The training will be organized around the basic simulator on Monday and more advanced topics and extensions on Tuesday. We will reserve a portion each day for interactive Q&A and guidance from the instructors, allowing deeper treatment of topics of particular interest.

The training is offered for \$500 USD/day for two days (\$1000 total). Training is provided free for students who meet the criteria for <u>IEEE student membership</u> (although IEEE membership is not required). All proceeds, after meeting costs are covered, will be deposited to the NS-3 Consortium gift account at the University of Washington, to support the open source project activities. A separate training flyer provides more details.

### Workshop on ns-3 (Wednesday/Thursday)

The seventh annual edition of the Workshop on ns-3 (WNS3) is a one and one-half day single-track workshop, beginning Wednesday morning.

The objective of the workshop is to gather ns-3 users and developers, together with networking simulation practitioners and users, and developers of other network simulation tools, to discuss the ns-3 simulator and related activities. The main agenda will be the presentation of accepted papers, but in addition, a poster and demo session will be held. The registration cost is \$100 for non-students, and free for students.

## **Consortium Annual Plenary Meeting (Thursday)**

On Thursday afternoon, the ns-3 Consortium Annual Plenary will be held. This meeting will consist of an overview and future plans for the project and the consortium activities, with time for discussion about the project.

#### **Developer meetings (Friday)**

As in years past, we will hold developer discussions following the Workshop on ns-3 regarding the future software development of the simulator. These meetings will allow ns-3 developers and maintainers to discuss topics face-to-face, and work on the code. The meetings are free and open to anyone, and agenda suggestions are welcome.
