#### **ICNS3**

- TH
- Need local organizer, to take on Alberto's job
- Need TPC co-chair, to work with TP
- o Timing worked well, 3rd week of August
- o In Belgium would need an experienced person to work closely with local organizers
- o If hosted by one of us the issues/work already known
- TP: create list of candidate venues, organizers
  - o Naples, Belgium.
  - o Canada?
  - Definitely need TPC co-chair
  - o Need venue organizer with experience, to work with local
- PB: once a year is valuable for the community
  - o Every two years seems very long
  - o TP: agree
- MT: agree on yearly
  - Seemed to have more interest this year: moving to Aug? changing name to "conference" (from "workshop") seems to have helped
  - Start planning 2027 before 2026, at least as far as selecting venue/host
    - So we can announce 2027 at end of 2026 meeting
    - So start working on venue for both years now

- Choice of library
  - o SA: Jiwoong probably willing to share his ongoing development
  - o TH: reluctant to take on maintenance and testing of a new private library, rather use something already in use externally
  - o TP: concern about external library churn, forcing us to catch up.
  - TH: regarding maintenance, burden will be on all of us, no matter which we choose. It's going to permeate code-base.
- Converting power in wifi
  - o Tedious, AI coding agents were not very helpful, made lots of mistakes
  - Next steps:
    - Remove some extraneous .toDouble()
    - Remove some extra casts in conversions (some WToDbm() and DbmToW() conversions can occur implicitly, without needing casts)
    - Port frequency quantities
    - Energy (current, power)
    - Mesh will need updating immediately
- SA: both approaches look viable
  - o Keep pushing ahead, to enable a decision soon
- TH: definitely think strong types will be helpful. Also eager to make a decision and keep pushing forward.

# Any other business

- PB: doxygen updates
  - Please look at these for correctness
    - doc: doxy: (fixes #1023) Fix various errors, reduce the maximum number of nodes in Doxygen-generated graphs

      - (Last commit will *not* be merged, it's useful to find what other doxy is missing. See the MR discussion)
  - Noisy clocks
    - Not quite the integration I envisioned
    - Willing to go ahead with what's proposed, circle back later to make local clocks easier to use

- TP: Would like to prioritize getting some help (from Stefano?) to fix #1132 (NS\_OBJECT\_TEMPLATE\_CLASS\_DEFINE doesn't play nice with namespaces) and #1260 (Address comparisons)
- SP: MR !2434 on print routing tables needs some resolution on the output format
- MT: may need Stefano's assistance with some upcoming changes to Wi-Fi examples; particularly Wi-Fi TCP example
